Momiji Health Care Society is a non-profit organization providing services to senior citizens of primarily Japanese-Canadian descent, in an effort to maximize their independence, health, and quality of life. We are currently seeking individuals interested in becoming a Personal Support Worker, but currently do not have the certification.

- Hourly Rate:** Competitive rate based on experience, with planned increases when PSW certification is achieved.

Details of the Program:

- Momiji is utilizing Government funding to help interested individuals become Personal Support Workers (PSWs) through programs at Ontario Colleges
- Successful candidates will be provided with a forgivable loan to pay for the cost of tuition and incidental fees to attend a PSW certification course
- The loan will be forgiven after working at Momiji for a minimum of 1 year post graduation
- Momiji will provide a basic salary while the individual is in school, along with one shift per week on site at Momiji

Responsibilities prior to graduation include, but are not limited to:

Service Delivery

- Staff will be primarily working with the tenants of Momiji Supportive Housing Residence
- Assisting clients daily living activities, including: light meal preparation, meal delivery, grocery shopping, laundry, and light house cleaning

Administrative Duties

- Meeting annual learning requirements through our internal training program
- Attending department meetings and recording minutes

General Duties

- Participate in other duties as directed
- Considerable standing, walking, lifting and bending will be required

A successful candidate will possess the following strengths/skills:

- Enthusiastic team player with good communication skills
- Strong organization and time management skills
- Patience with and understanding of cognitively impaired clients
- Effective communication skills in English, both oral and written, are essential; Japanese language skills are a definite asset
- Familiarity with computers is an asset; email, excel and online training are part of daily job activities

Required Certificates:

- Police Vulnerable Sector Check must be completed during probation period, Momiji to assist with process once hired.
- Current first aid/CPR certificate
- Hep B Immunization, TB test and immunization record required
