We Did It!

Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle Campaign a success



ince 1993, Momiji Health Care Society has been transporting seniors, mainly of Japanese descent, to medical appointments, grocery shopping, banking, social\recreational\cultural outings, and other day-to-day activities important in their lives. Momiji understands that maintaining their independence and retaining their community relationships is important for seniors and helps them stay healthy and improves their quality of life.

Our 15-year-old nine passenger wheelchair accessible vehicle has been a crucial part of this service. Without it, 79 Momiii tenants who are wheelchair bound or who have other mobility issues would not be able to use our transportation services thus prohibiting them from participating in outside activities and community events. Seniors living in longterm care residences that are partnered with Momiji, as well as seniors living in the community would also be impacted.

When this vehicle started experiencing more frequent engine trouble, resulting in costly repairs, we knew a fundraising campaign to purchase a new vehicle was a necessity.

The Momiji Bazaar Committee was the first to respond with a \$15,000 lead gift. Over the next few months of the campaign, we were fortunate to receive a \$10,000 donation from the Nelson Arthur Hyland Foundation, followed by a \$20,000 commitment from the Toronto Chapter of the National Association of Japanese Canadians (NAJC), then a \$25,000 gift from Ocean Food Company Limited. Throughout the campaign, we were also blessed with many generous donations from individuals and families. Thanks to the generosity of all our donors, the campaign was completed ahead of schedule and raised more than the \$88,595 goal.

On top of this success, the Central East Local Health Integrated Network (CELHIN) granted Momiji's transportation services \$40,000 for capital expenses. Combining this with the funds already raised, Momiji is now in the process of purchasing a new Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle as well as a new seven person van.

A NEW PARTNERSHIP

The National Association of Japanese Canadians (NAJC) is a non-profit that represents the Japanese Canadian community. They successfully negotiated the historic Redress Settlement on behalf of all Japanese Canadians who suffered injustice at the hands of their own government during and after WWII when they were forcibly relocated and incarcerated.

They have branches located all across Canada.

Momiji, with the help of Board member and tenant Susan Hidaka, approached the Toronto Chapter of the NAJC to assist with the funding of the new Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle. After a presentation, the organization agreed to contribute an incredible \$20,000. "After some discussion, it didn't take us long to agree that the generation of Japanese who fought for Redress are indeed in need of urgent assistance and the Toronto Chapter of the NAJC would like to help," stated Bruce Tatemichi, Vice President and Acting President, Toronto Chapter of NAJC. "Many of us on the board have friends and family under Momiji's care and we appreciate all that you do for our beloved seniors."

24/7 MOMIJI CARE

Momiji was successful in securing additional base funding from the CELHIN which has allowed us to offer PSW overnight services from 11:00pm to 7:00am. This service started in September and means peace of mind for tenants and their families 24 hours per day, seven days a week.

Momiji now provides overnight security checks for tenants at high risk of falling, personal care for tenants with temporary and ongoing health issues, and offers laundry services for numerous tenants saving hundreds of dollars in hydro charges. In just the past three months, Momiji staff have responded and quickly resolved 11 overnight incidents - 64% were falls and 5 incidents required sending the tenant to the hospital. Thanks go to our dedicated Support Services management and PSW staff for this invaluable service.

車椅子で乗車可能な9人乗りバンは 15年目を迎え古くなりました。車椅子 で移動が必要なモミジ居住者79人をは じめ長期ケア施設や地域で暮らすシニアの方々にとってこのバンは建物外での活動やコミュニティとの繋がりに不可欠です。

古いバンは故障が増え修理費が高く つき、新車購入のための募金が必要に なりました。
