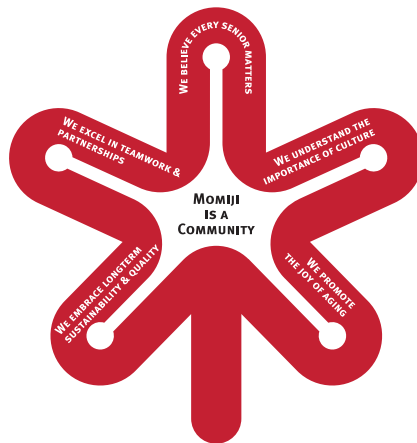

The Momiji family was saddened to learn of the recent passing of Kazuo Oiye. Mr. Oiye was one of the Founders of Momiji Health Care Society (MHCS). As a lawyer, QC, he advised on Momiji's legal matters and was intricately involved in creating the original application for the building of the Momiji Senior Residence and incorporating MHCS. He was part of the team who travelled to Japan to approach several corporations where they raised considerable funds for the building. He was also a founding member of the Board of Directors for the Momiji Foundation. Mr. Oiye had a unique ability to think outside the box, which was instrumental to our organization. Our sympathies are extended to his family - sister Keiko, brother Roy (Florence), daughter Heather, son Kevin (Pam) and son David.

MOMIJI HEALTH CARE SOCIETY AND JAPANESE SOCIAL SERVICES – EXPANDED PARTNERSHIP

For the third year in a row, Momiji was extremely fortunate to receive a generous \$8,000 grant from the Ontario Seniors' Secretariat. This year's grant allows us to partner with Japanese Social Services (JSS) on two main senior's events. The first event will be hosted by the JSS and is a Lunch-'n-Learn with the Wynford Seniors Club. Held at the Japanese Canadian Cultural Centre on Wednesday, October 4th from 11:00 am – 1:30 pm, the topic is "Keeping Yourself Safe as an Older Person". The JSS will help participants wade through the abundance of resources pertaining to elder care and wellness that are available to seniors including their families, friends and support network.

This session will be of particular interest to seniors who may feel vulnerable or who have safety concerns. The session will be held in English with a Japanese interpreter. 2017 marks the 75th Anniversary of the beginning of the displacement and internment of Japanese Canadians. The Toronto Chapter, National Association of Japanese Canadians (TorontoNAJC) is hosting a luncheon at Momiji Seniors Centre on Saturday, November 25th from noon to 4:00 pm to honour and recognize these individuals for their courage and determination

as they suffered through losing their homes, possessions and their livelihood only to rebuild their lives in a new location. Contributing partners include Momiji Health Care Society, Toronto Buddhist Church, the Japanese Canadian Cultural Centre Heritage Committee and the National Association of Japanese Canadians. NEW WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE VAN

Momiji's new wheelchair accessible van is coming soon! As previously reported, our Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle Campaign was a great success, thanks to all of our generous donors including Ocean Food Company Ltd., the Toronto Chapter of the National Association of Japanese Canadians, the Nelson Arthur Hyland Foundation, the Momiji Bazaar Committee, and so many individual donors. We also received a special grant from our fun-

ders at the Central East LHIN. So, in April, we ordered our new vehicle: a custom-built van from Crestline Coach, a Canadian company, that holds two wheelchairs and eight ambulatory passengers, and offers up-to-date technology, comfort and safety features that our current, unreliable, 16-year-old van lacks. We're very eager to get it here!

Although the van was ordered in April, Crestline unfortunately didn't receive the chassis from the manufacturer (Ford) until July – the month that we had originally anticipated delivery of the com-

pleted customized vehicle. Crestline estimates that delivery will be during the last week of September. We apologize to all those seniors who were looking forward to using the new van this summer... and of course, to all of the donors who are still waiting eagerly to see the new vehicle they paid for. We know that this new vehicle will be worth the wait, making transportation safer, more comfortable, and more pleasurable for the entire Momiji community.

MOMIJI BOWLATHON

In May, Momiji hosted over 160 participants at our 12th Annual Fundraising Bowlathon. The Bowlathon was held at two different locations again this year: five-pin teams at Parkway and 10-pin teams at Richmond Hill ProBowling. The Awards Ceremony, complete with a delicious Bento Box dinner, was held at Momiji which allowed all of our bowlers to be together, compare stories and discover who our award winners were!

As in the past, the bowling fees and the cost of the meal were priced to be affordable and provide no profit so it was the sponsorships that the participants solicited from family, friends and community members that were the principal

fundraising sources for this event. Thanks to our bowlers and our donors, just over \$45,000 was raised which was a record for the seventh year in a row.

These funds will allow Momiji to complete some important projects, like finishing our Momiji Café renovations and fixing the ventilation in the EPC. They will also be used to help run our Elderly Persons Centre (EPC) program. Although our EPC receives government funding, we always need to raise additional funds to cover the full cost of the program. Some of the additional funds that the EPC receives are provided by the Momiji Café,
