FRANK HIROSHI HORI – His Generosity Lives On

Frank Hiroshi Hori was born in Vancouver in 1927. He and his seven siblings grew up in a home filled with love, warmth and camaraderie of family and many Japanese friends.

During the war, the family was sent to Slocan where they lived for two years before relocating to Regina. Frank attended the Regina College, followed by McGill University where he studied business and accounting. He always remembered the funding support that was provided by his siblings toward his post secondary education.

Frank was highly proficient with a stellar acumen for business. His 30 year career started at Premium Forest Products, a Toronto based door manufacturer. The company was renamed Premdor Inc. when Frank and his partners purchased it. Premdor was made public, allowing for international opportunities. When Frank retired, he was Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of Premdor Inc. and Vice Chairman and Director of Masonite International, a subsidiary.

In 1999, Frank established The Frank H. Hori Charitable Foundation which fo-

cuses on preserving Japanese cultural heritage, creating opportunities for young people and enriching society. Frank passed away in 2011 but his Foundation continues on, under the careful management of his three trustees.

Momiji Health Care Society would like to thank The Frank H. Hori Charitable Foundation for their extraordinary

generosity to our organization. Since 2013, they have donated almost \$550,000 to our organization, supporting our Preserve the Legacy Capital Campaign and our Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle Campaign. We were pleased to rename the Momiji Centre to the Frank H. Hori Community Centre in honour of the Foundation's generosity. More recently, the Foundation was a Platinum Sponsor of our Gala and has recently made a donation to our new Momiji Community Wellness Fund.

YONE KOBAYASHI: Grandmother, Mother, Volunteer, Philanthropist

Yone Kobayashi was born in Vancouver on March 30, 1918, to Toki (Furumi) and Toragoro Matsui. One of six children, including her brother Roy Matsui who was Momiji's architect, she was uprooted to Toronto during World War II because of her Japanese ancestry. In Toronto, she worked as a maid and seamstress, and later as the office manager for an Osteopathic Doctor. In 1947, she married 'Coby' Yutaka Kobayashi and they began a life-long journey, using her savings as seed capital to start some of his many successful entrepreneurial ventures.

Yone and Coby had three children, Cassandra, Martin and Robert, and five grandchildren, Alexa, Kristin, Kevin, Mitchell and Austin. She was an excellent Scrabble player and had a real passion for bunka-shishu, sumi-e, clothing design and many other crafts. She and Coby, who passed away in 1999, were Founding Members and lifetime supporters of the Japanese Canadian Cultural

Centre. Their contributions have left indelible marks on the halls, the walls, and the souls of the JCCC.

Mrs. Kobayashi moved into Momiji in February 2003, where she lived for more than 4 years. While living at Momiji, she participated and volunteered in many Momiji activities and events. In June 2007, she moved back to Vancouver, for a brief and happy time before her passing in January 2008.

Momiji Health Care Society was proud to be able to use our 40th Anniversary Gala to recognize an extremely generous \$500,000 donation, made by Mrs. Kobayashi's Estate to the Momiji Foundation which is a very generous supporter of our organization. Her son, Marty, said that his Mom was "...very grateful to Momiji for providing a warm and inviting environment for JCs in their senior years. My Mom enjoyed her time living at Momiji and wanted to express her appreciation to a great organization".

We were touched that she chose to leave a part of her legacy to Momiji that will last far beyond our lifetimes.

THE MOMIJI COMMUNITY WELLNESS FUND – Addressing the Gap

When Momiji Seniors Residence first opened in 1992, the tenants were younger – 77 was the average age, they were more active and they were independent in their apartments. In many ways, the tenants looked after Momiji themselves, taking care of the gardening, holding fundraising activities like the annual Bazaar and social events like the annual Tenant BBQ. There was only one Momiji staff person and one part-time Personal Support Worker (PSW) who helped with light housekeeping. And there was no wait list.

Momiji looks very different in 2018.

The average age of our tenants is now 89 years old and the average move-in-age is 85 years. With age comes increasingly complex care needs, much more than a supportive housing organization can provide. Momiji now has eight full-time, six part-time and nine on calls PSWs. A typical work week for these PSWs has evolved from 25 hours per week of light housekeeping to increasingly heavy personal care at 650 hours per week. And our wait list is now over 750 individuals who are currently living in their own homes or with family. Most have the same care needs as our tenants. These applicants are part of our community and we keep in touch with them and encourage them to participate in our in-house and outreach programs. As their needs rise, we also need to expand our offerings to them.

As the seniors we serve age, there is a widening gap between the financial support we receive – from funders, including the government and Momiji Foundation, money raised at our fundraising events, and general donations – and what the actual costs are.

To address this gap and in honour of our 40th Anniversary, we launched a new multi year, \$3.5 million Campaign at our 40th Anniversary Gala. The Momiji Community Wellness Fund will allow us to sustain, enhance and eventually expand Support Services and programs to our tenants and to the broader community. The Momiji Community Bazaar is an annual event, held at the end of March that brings together hundreds of volunteers to sort and set up merchandise, prepare food for the event, and then welcome hundreds of people from the broader community. First started 28 years ago at the Toronto Buddhist Church, the event has now grown to use most of the second floor of the Frank H. Hori Community Centre (formerly the Momiji Centre) and a large section of our underground visitor's parking garage where the best deals, and some of our most enthusiastic volunteers, can be found.

Shoppers come from all over for the delicious homemade Japanese food including Manju, Chow Mein, Bento Boxes and Sushi. And our dining room sells our ever popular Teishoku plate, a Japanese set meal where all of the dishes in the course are served together. Have a sweet tooth? Our bake table is always full of a variety of donated goods – squares, cupcakes, cookies and more. And our Pie Place is filled with homemade pies including lemon and apple.

In addition to the great food, there are plenty of items for sale including Pink Elephant (china and glass ware), Books, Jewellery, Fabric and Crafts, Japanese

Wares and Collectibles.

Our volunteers are crucial to the success of this event but we also rely on the generosity of corporations and organizations for donations. Special thanks to our Bazaar Committee and especially our Co-Chairs Mayumi Maemura and Chris Okawara, who has volunteered her time and expertise to this event for an amazing 20 years. The 2018

Bazaar was our most successful, raising a gross total of just over \$42,000.

Volunteers are not only required on the day of the event but also to help with our various Bees since all of the food sold at the Bazaar is made by our volunteers. Bees include Manju, Sushi and Pies. MOMIJI'S 13TH ANNUAL FUNDRAIS- ING BOWLATHON: A Striking Success

Momiji's first Bowlathon was held in 2006, with modest hopes for participation and funds raised. Fortunately, the Bowlathon Committee and community members involved with bowling leagues were the primary supporters of the event and made it a "fun" fundraiser. Hence, the Momiji Bowlathon became an annual event. And although there were some lean years, as more bowlers became aware of the event, participation levels have increased.

In June of this year, we welcomed 143 bowlers to this event. In the afternoon, the 5-pin bowling was held at Parkway Bowl while the 10-pin was held at World Bowl. In the evening, bowlers, friends and supporters joined us at Momiji for a Bento Meal and our infamous Awards Ceremony. Bowler registration fees only cover bowling lineage and meal costs so this fundraiser relies on sponsorship money that the bowlers solicit from family, friends, work colleagues and community

members in the months and days leading up to the event. Funds raised have increased significantly over the past few years.

This year, we had 18 new bowlers and 45 have participated in this fundraising

We are truly grateful for their continued support and help in making a difference in the lives of seniors. フランク・ヒロシ・ホリ氏 引き継がれる遺志

フランク・ホリ氏は1927年にバンクーバーで生まれ、7人の兄弟姉妹と共に家族の愛情に恵まれ多くの日系人に支えられ成長しました。

一家は大戦時にスローカンに収容され、2年後にリジャイナへ移住。その後、ホリ氏はリジャイナカレッジからマギル大学経営学部へと進学。兄弟姉妹の経済的な支えで卒業できたことを常に感謝していました。

ホリ氏は経営の洞察力に優れていました。最初に就職したトロントのドア製造会社Premium Forest Products社を

パートナーと共に引き継ぎPremodor社に改名。株式を公開し取引を海外へと拡大。同社の副社長・最高財務責任者、ならびに子会社のMasonite Internationalの副会長・取締役を務めました。

ホリ氏は1999年に「フランク・H・ホリ慈善財団」を設立。目的は日系文化継承の維持、若者の機会創出、社会支援です。2011年のホリ氏逝去後も同基金は3人の管財人によって運営されています。

モミジは同財団から多大なる支援を受けています。2013年から現在までの寄付額は55万ドル。「レガシー保存」と「車椅子乗車可能なバン」の募金に大きな助けとなりました。同財団に敬意を表し、モミジセンターは「フランク・H・ホリ・コミュニティセンター」に改名。新たな「コミュニティ・ウェルネス基金」にもプラチナスポンサーとして多額の寄付を受けました。心より感謝いたします。

モミジ・コミュニティ・ウェルネス基金

1992年モミジ・シニアレジデンス開設時、居住者平均年齢は77歳でした。多くの方々が活動的で、モミジ庭園の管理、バザーなどの募金活動やBBQなどの催し物を率先しました。当時、職員は1名。軽労働（家事手伝い）のパートタイムのパーソナル・サポートワーカー（PSW）が1名。入居待ちもありませんでした。

2018年の状況は全く異なります。居住者平均年齢89歳。入居時平均年齢85歳。高齢化と共に複雑なケアの需要が増え、自立支援型住宅の限界を超えた状態です。モミジのPSWはフルタイム8名、パートタイム6名、常時待機9名。職務は当時の週25時間から週650時間に。軽労働から介護を含む重労働が増加。入居待ち750人以上。その多くが同様のケアを必要としています。モミジは入居待ちの方々と繋がりを持しモミジセンターや地域連携のプログラムに参加されるように勧めています。需要増加に対応したサービス/プログラムの拡張が必須です。

EXTERIOR CAULKING

Our Director of Seniors Residence has retained a caulking contractor to repair exterior caulking deficiencies that were noted during the ice/rain storm in April and severe rain storm in September. Unfortunately, some apartments had water damage due to leaking.

Deterioration of the caulking for the pre-cast concrete panels, windows and

metal siding was noted during the Reserve Fund Study inspection in May 2017. The Ministry of Health was consulted about the exterior caulking and we were informed that this project could be funded under the Social Housing Apartment Improvement Program. A detailed application was submitted along with other energy efficiency retrofit projects in early 2018 however a change in Provincial government's cap and trade initiatives

have resulted in Momiji funding the project with their Replacement Reserves.

Work will begin on the project in mid October, starting with the south elevation first. Contractors will be using a swing stage so there will be no need to access each apartment. The scheduled timeline for the south elevation caulking is six weeks. The contractor could delay the north elevation caulking until the spring due to the cold weather.
